HackerYou Privacy Policy

Website Visitors

HackerYou's website collects non-personally-identifying information that web browsers and servers typically make available, such as the browser type, language preference, referring site, and the date and time of each visitor request.

Our purpose in collecting this information is to better understand how visitors use our website. From time to time, we may release this information in the aggregate, e.g., by publishing a report on trends in the usage of our website.

Voluntary Data Collection

Prospective applicants to HackerYou's various courses and programs are required to submit personally-identifying information as part of their application.

We only collect information that is necessary or appropriate. Visitors can always refuse to supply this information, but it may prevent you from applying to our courses.

Protection of Certain Personally-Identifying Information

HackerYou discloses personally-identifying information only to those of its employees, contractors, and affiliated organizations that (i) need to know that information in order to process it on HackerYou's behalf, or to provide services, and (ii) that have agreed not to disclose it to others. Some of those employees, contractors and affiliated organizations may be located outside of your home country; by using HackerYou's website or its service, you consent to the transfer of such information to them.

HackerYou will not rent or sell your personal information to anyone. If you have supplied your email address to HackerYou, you consent to receive occasional information about new courses, to solicit your feedback on how we're doing, or to keep you up to date with what's going on with HackerYou and our programs. You may opt-out of these any time.

If you send us a request we reserve the right to publish it in order to help us clarify or respond to your request or to help us support other users. HackerYou takes all measures reasonably necessary to protect against the unauthorized access, use, alteration, or destruction of potentially personally-identifying and personally-identifying information.

All copyrights, patents, designs and other intellectual property rights in or relating to any course materials provided or made available in connection with our courses remain the sole property of HackerYou.
